

Victorian Housing Register transition report explained

The transition report for Victorian Housing Register applications will show the number of applications in the register by type.

The report includes the number of:

- Existing public housing applications moved to the register
- New applications submitted since August 2016: applicants may have chosen public housing, community housing or both
- Community housing applications yet to be transferred to the register
- Community housing applications transferred to the register (this process will start in early 2017)
- Applications for social housing in total: This number will change as existing community housing applications are reviewed and consolidated.
