Get down low and **stay under** the smoke



Leave and **CLOSE** the door to your room



- Alert others as you leave and assist if safe to do so
- **Never go back** into a burning room or building



**CALL 000** (zero, zero, zero)

- · From a mobile phone
- Or a neighbour's phone
- Ask for FIRF



**MOVE** to assembly area nominated on the emergency evacuation plan for your Rooming House and remain there.

**Note:** You should become familiar with the **EMERGENCY EVACUATION PROCEDURE** floor plans that are located in the main passageways of your Rooming House.
