
2022 Victorian Public Housing Resident Survey

Overview

In 2022, Homes Victoria surveyed 3,755 residents living in public housing across Victoria. Residents were asked their views on their home, public housing services, their feelings of safety and security, connection to their neighbourhood and community diversity.


The 2022 survey included additional questions to explore residents' digital literacy and internet access, residents' engagement with contractors, police and housing offices and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander residents' cultural safety and connection. The sample size also slightly increased, to ensure survey results are representative of the public housing population.


The Resident Survey is the largest single jurisdiction survey of public housing residents in the country. It has been previously carried out in 2019 and 2020 and over the three waves we have completed 9,000 interviews.

The Resident Survey helps Homes Victoria better understand the lived experience of public housing residents. By incorporating the voice of residents, Homes Victoria can improve services and outcomes for residents.







Thinking about your home internet usage, to what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statements?





In relation to your feelings of safety in the last 12 months, how do you feel in these circumstances?




In the past 12 months, how often have you experienced or witnessed any of the following in your neighbourhood?












How often do you currently smoke cigarettes, cigars, pipes or any other tobacco products?




In the last 12 months, were there any times that you ran out of food and could not afford to buy more?

(family emergency or medical treatment) (includes accessing own savings, borrowing money, or using a credit card)?






Over the last 12 months, did you undertake any volunteer work?




How often have you helped out as a volunteer in the last 12 months?




Do you have close friends or family whom you talk to regularly?




Do you feel comfortable asking a neighbour to borrow a cup of sugar or some rice?









Could a relative or friend who is not living with you care for you (or your children) in an emergency?




